

Cleburne's Got Talent - Contest Rules

- All contestants must check in back stage one (1) hour prior to the start of the show.
- Contestants must provide their own musical instruments and/or stage props.
- Contestants requiring special music, such as in dance or other routine, must supply music on a CD and have it available at the time of check in.
- Contestants will be given a number at Check In. This number **does not reflect the order** in which you will perform but rather will serve as ID for the judges.
- Vocal contestants needing Karaoke style backup music must provide their own disc (some discs may be available at the show to choose from, but there are no guarantees. No lyrics will be displayed during the contest.
- Contestants will dress stage appropriate for a family event. If there is any question contestant should clear it with the Talent Coordinator prior to the day of competition.
- No contestant, adult or otherwise, shall perform intoxicated.

NO EXCEPTIONS.....THIS IS A FAMILY EVENT

Contestants will be judged on:

- Talent, difficulty
- Performance on stage
- Appearance, costume, etc.
- Charisma, energy, effort,
- Overall Entertainment value

SCORING:

Will be a scale of 1-10 on each area listed above.

Judges:

Will be introduced prior to Show Time on Saturday, May 2nd.
